

# FRANKLINTON CHURCH PLANT *Basics*

## Why Franklinton?

Franklin County is the fastest growing county in North Carolina (with the exception of those on the coast) and the town of Franklinton is projected to grow by 20% in the next 10 years. Of those who currently live in Franklinton, 74% are unchurched. Plus, there are 256 Faith members and regular attenders who live in Franklinton.

## What's the Plan?

We'll plant an autonomous church in Franklinton over the next 3-5 years in a slightly different way than our previous church plant partnerships. During this time, the Franklinton church plant (led by planting pastor Chandler Donegan) and Faith Youngsville will share our mission, vision, and values, discipleship pathway, ministry philosophies, leadership structure, budget, and weekly Sunday morning rhythms.
