KEY VERSES

- 1:13-14 "Hold on to the pattern of sound teaching that you have heard from me, in the faith
 and love that are in Christ Jesus. Guard the good deposit through the Holy Spirit who lives in us."
- 2:1-2 "You, therefore, my son, be strong in the grace that is in Christ Jesus. What you have heard from me in the presence of many witnesses, commit to faithful men who will be able to teach others also."
- 2:11-13 "This saying is trustworthy: For if we died with him, we will also live with him; if we endure, we will also reign with him; if we deny him, he will also deny us; 13 if we are faithless, he remains faithful, for he cannot deny himself."
