**BOOK BASICS** 

Witnesses

The book of Joshua is named for the most famous member of the Israelites in the generation that crossed the Jordan River and entered the promised land of Canaan. Their battles and faithfulness have a place among the greatest stories of the faith in the Old Testament.

Joshua led the people to defeat the adversaries who opposed God's people. He then oversaw the division of the land into the tribal allotments. Finally, Joshua renewed the people and God.

The book of Joshua also points us to the new and better Joshua in Jesus Himself. Joshua's trust, faithfulness, and obedience to God led to victories over the enemies of God. These victories gave the Israelites victorious rest in the land that God had promised Abraham. Jesus' life, trust, and faithfulness to God grants victory over death, hell, sin, and the grave to all those who confess and believe in Him. For those that do, we too are promised a home. Only our home will be in heaven where we will forever be in the presence of Jesus Himself.
